Local Rules and Information

- Out of Bounds- One stroke and hit 2nd ball from same location as 1st ball.
- 2. <u>Lost Ball</u> –One stroke and hit 2nd ball from same location as 1st ball.
- 3. <u>Unplayable Lie-One</u> stroke and drop within 2 club lengths OR drop back as far as desired on a line to the hole.
- In A RED Water Hazard-One stroke and hit 2nd ball from drop zone on the other side of the pond. (local rule)
- 5. <u>Hitting Wrong Ball</u>-Two strokes OR loss of hole in match play
- Giving or asking advice-Two strokes OR loss of hole in match play
- 7. Agreeing to Waive a Rule-Disqualification
- 8. Artificial Obstruction Interferes
 With Stance and Swing-One club
 length relief no closer to the hole
 with no penalty(except boundary
 objects)

Scoring Procedures to Follow

- Each week Players fill in their scores in the Captain's book
- Post your own gross score in the GHIN app every time you play.
- Chip-in and birdies will be recorded weekly in the Captain's Book

ETIQUTTE

- Arrive 30 minutes early.
- Keep the pace of play.
- Always be courteous.
- Do not leave cart in front of greens.
- Repair ball marks, replace divots, and rake sand.
- Do not walk or stand on the line of a putt on green.
- Do not talk when players are hitting or putting.
- Do not hit into players ahead.
- Let faster groups play through.
- If you are one or more holes behind the group in front of you, please let the group behind play through if they are waiting.

If you sign up for an event and cannot attend, it is your responsibility to cancel by notifying our Sun Country Chair for that event.
